

What to Do in Adoration?

- 1. Pray the Psalms or the Liturgy of the Hours. Whether you are praising, giving thanks, asking for forgiveness or seeking an answer, you'll find an appropriate psalm. The ancient prayer of the Church, called the Liturgy of the Hours, presents an excellent way to pray through the book of Psalms throughout the year.
- 2. Recite the "Jesus Prayer." Say "Lord Jesus Christ, have mercy on me a sinner," repeatedly as you quiet your heart and mind.

CHRIST THE REDEEMER EVANGELIZATION & DISCIPLESHIP MINISTRY

The Evangelization and Discipleship Ministry is part of the Pastoral Program of Christ the Redeemer Parish. Evangelization is bringing the good news of Jesus Christ to those around us. Jesus Himself commanded us to evangelize. The Church exists to give witness to the Gospel and spread the good news to others that Jesus loves them and desires everlasting Life for them in His Kingdom. Our Ministry provides Programs, Seminars, Movies and Gatherings that will educate, renew and inspire our Parishioners and others to Discover, Follow and Share Christ and spread His Good Word.

- Our Ministry has offered the Christ Life Series which started in the Fall of 2021 and scheduled for completion in June of 2022. The three individual seven-week seminars help those who participate, to learn more about our Savior Jesus Christ and establish a personal relationship with Him.
- Through the course of the year, we also offer "Movie Night" where we present films about the Saints and the Bible. In 2021 we featured films about St. Francis and St. Rita and films about the Bible with "Ruth, Queen Esther and Jesus." Starting in April we will present films about Noah, Jonah, Moses and Joseph from the Old Testament of the Bible.
- Our Parish has now formed Four Small Christian Communities and soon will have five. Small Christian
 Communities of 5-8 members meet to read and discuss Scripture, reflect on how Scripture plays a part in our
 lives, pray, share friendship with each other and assist with Parish initiatives and those of the Community. Three
 Groups are meeting in the Leaders home and one group is meeting in the Pastoral Center. These Groups
 met for Advent and are now gathering each week for Lent.
- Our Parish is actively involved with the Atco Ministerium of Christian Churches. Being united with our Christian
 Brothers and Sisters helps to advance our Common Goals of loving and serving God and evangelizing others
 to learn the good news of Jesus. We are currently offering a beautiful Lenten Program in the Parish Hall called
 Soup, Bread and Scripture. This is a Ministerium event where all the Churches of Atco are assisting in
 the Program.
- In June, July and August we will be conducting "Outreach" at the Berlin Farmers Market. We set up a tent and table and offer those walking by with rosary beads, pamphlets, books and prayer cards. We write down the names of their family or friends who may need special prayers.

We talk, interact, and answer any questions about Jesus, the Bible and our Faith. What is so beautiful about this mission, is that we meet people who may be strangers to us, but not God. Those who have faith, and eagerly want to share it, and discuss it with us.

We love offering and sharing these programs with you and hope you will continue to attend and spread the word about our programs and ask that you would volunteer to help us. Thank-You!
