Bereavement Ministry

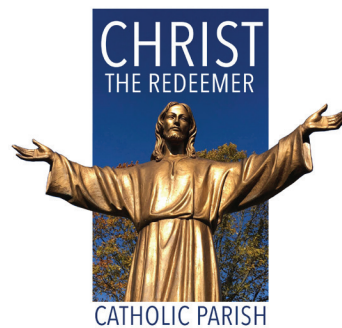
