Bereavement Ministry

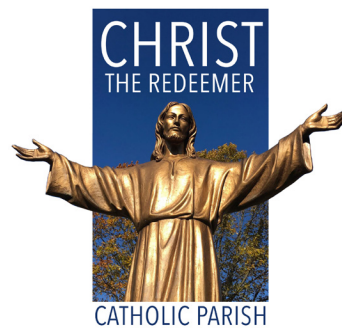

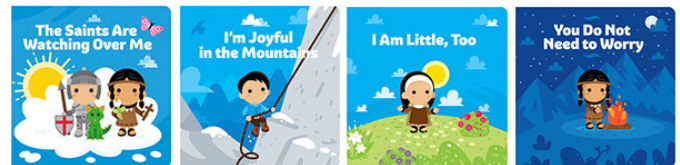
