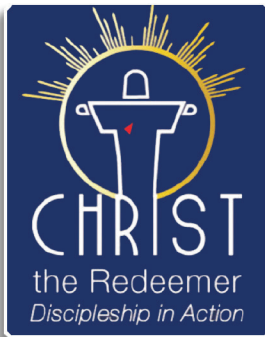

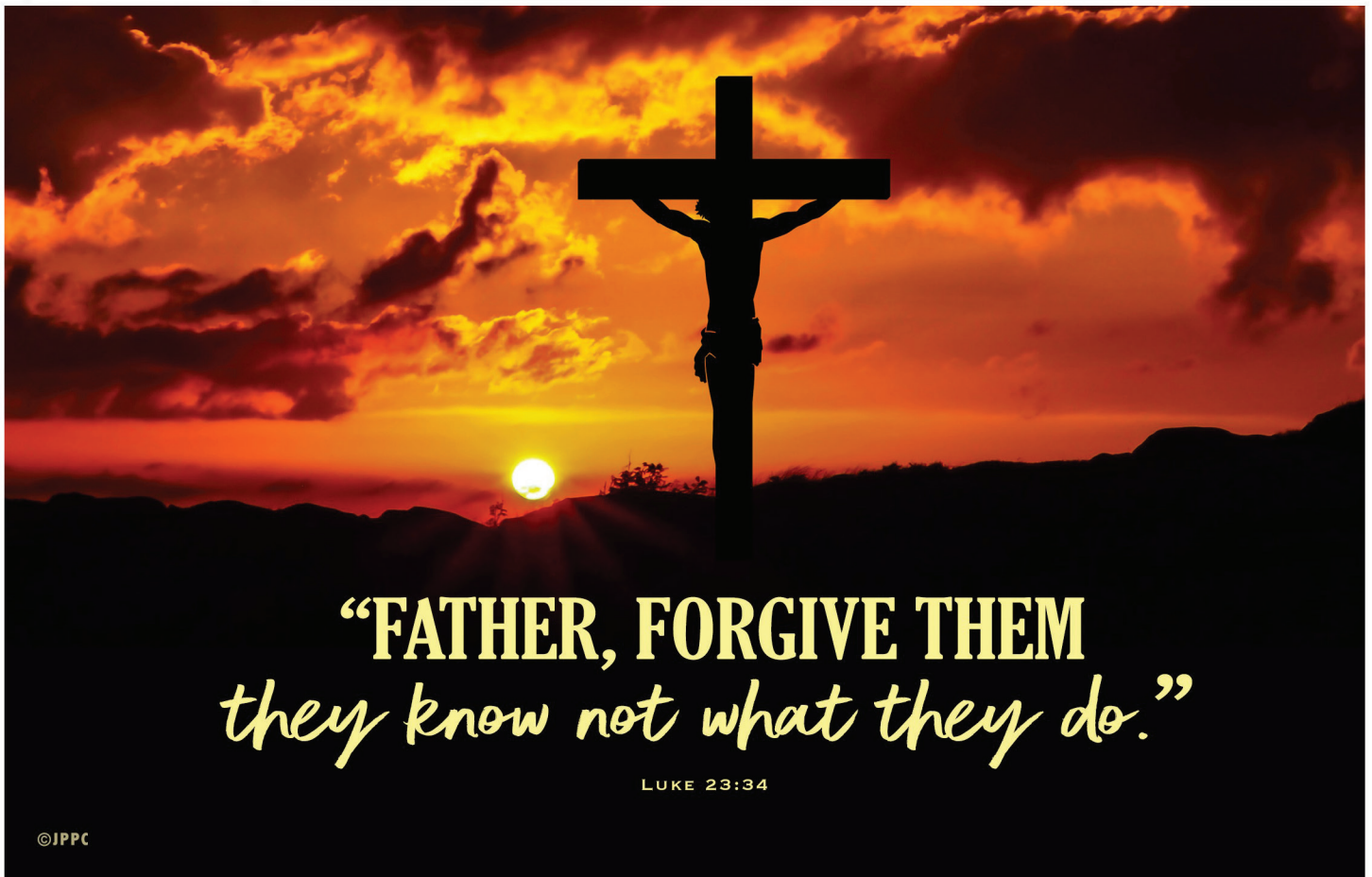

Bereavement Ministry

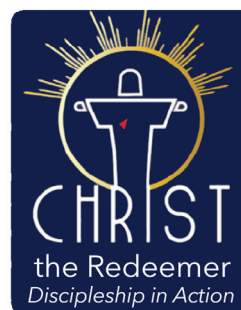

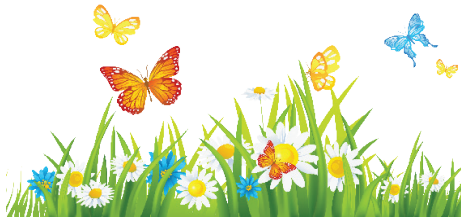

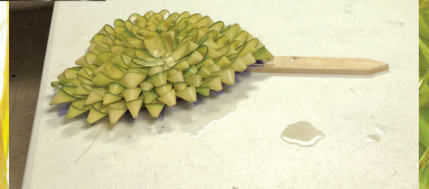


Catholic Definition
