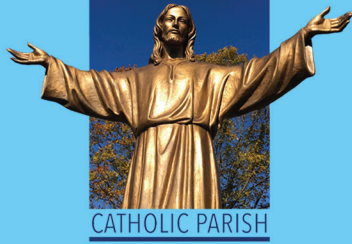

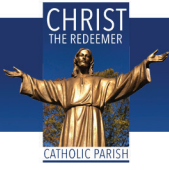

On July 16, 2022, the United States transitioned the 10-digit National Suicide Prevention Lifeline to **988** an easy to remember three-digit number for 24/7 crisis care. The lifeline, which also links to the Veterans Crisis Line, follows a three-year joint effort by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Federal Communications Commission (FCC), and the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to put crisis care more in reach of people in need.

Bereavement Ministry

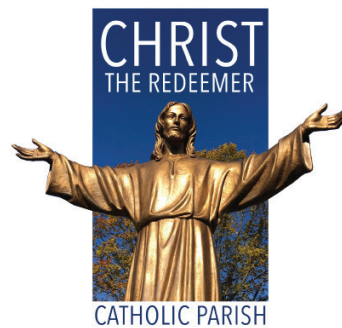
