

All money raised from this bag bingo will be donated directly to Christ the Redeemer Parish.




Eucharistic Miracles

Cremated remains are the body of the deceased in a changed form. We should honor them as we honor the body. They must be reverently buried or entombed in a place reserved for the burial of the dead. Bereavement Ministry


