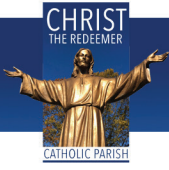

Bereavement Ministry

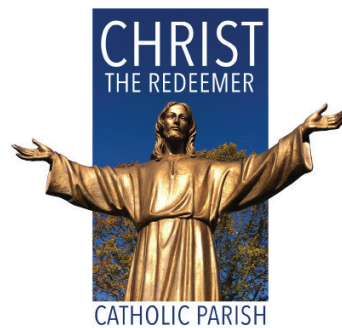
