

Seek the LORD, all you humble of the earth, who have observed his law; seek justice, seek humility; perhaps you may be sheltered on the day of the LORD's anger.

Nursing Ministry





Stewards Deny Self

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." Matthew 5: 3

The phrase "poor in spirit" can be confusing. Think of it in this sense - poor in spirit means depending on God's providence and not depending on our own self-reliance. Being detached from earthly things (power, money, and comfort) and attached to heavenly things (charity, sacrifice, and mercy). **Stewardship** is denying ourselves from satisfying our desires and helping others obtain their basic needs.

The Holy See is a completely different entity from the Vatican City. The Vatican City is a sovereign territory that has been in existence since 1929 while the Holy See has been around since the beginning of the Church. It is the Holy See that sends and receives ambassadors to and from other nations. The Roman Curia is the administrative body of the Holy See and is based in a complex system of offices and buildings, which include the Lateran Palace and St. Peter's Basilica.


