

### **Bereavement Ministry**



First Reading: Genesis 18: 20-32



#### **Catholic Definition**

Altar: The center and focal point of a church, where the sacrifice of Christ on the cross is made present under sacramental signs in the Mass. Among the Israelites the altar was the place where sacrifices were offered to God. The Christian altar represents two aspects of the mystery of the Eucharist, as the altar of sacrifice where Christ as the sacrificial victim offers himself for our sins and as the table of the Lord where Christ gives himself to us as food from heaven. (CCC1182,1383)





Christ the Redeemer Parish has a long and deep devotion to **St. Rita of Cascia** beginning in the 1940s. The Pangia Family began the St. Rita's Society at our Parish. The Society ran through the 1960s. In May of 2015 a group of devotees revived the St. Rita's Ministry praying the nine-day Novena to St. Rita, which ends on St. Rita's feast day of May 22nd. As an outgrowth of the annual devotion, the St. Rita's Intercessors arose. They meet on the 22nd of each month to pray the Novena.

In the several years since reactivating the Ministry, a new statue was added to the church and the Parish Hall was named in her honor.

Thank you to everyone involved in this Special Ministry, especially those who are involved in the planning of all the activities for the Novena, the parishioners who have donated items or money, all the parishioners who attend the Novena, and all those who attend the monthly Intercessors group.

## A Message from Joe Bednar

Dear Parishioner,

The Evangelization/Discipleship Ministry recently concluded the **"Sharing Christ"** sessions from the Christ Life Series.

We finished with a beautiful Retreat Day at the Discovery House with Msgr. Michael Mannion. Our "PRESENCE" video series in Assumption Church ended two weeks ago. This series was well attended and had a very "impactful" message about God's Presence in the Holy Eucharist from a Biblical, Liturgical and Personal Standpoint. As Deacon Joe discussed in his reflection in the Bulletin last week, we are in the midst of a 3-year program about every Catholic renewing their adoration of and participation in the Holy Eucharist.

Our Eucharistic Revival Team, as well as several of our parishioners participated in the Diocese opening of the Eucharistic Revival on Saturday night June 18th, in Atlantic City, with a walk on the boardwalk from Tennessee Avenue to Kennedy Plaza. Overall, the parish participation was better than expected with 1000+ walking behind their parish banners. Bishop Sullivan spoke to all at Kennedy Plaza as the walk concluded.

The "PRESENCE" video series opened our Eucharistic Revival at the parish level. We will continue with our Parish Observance of the Eucharistic Revival with another video series being held in Assumption Church in September.

"THE BIBLICAL WALKTHROUGH OF THE MASS" will be presented as a 5-week series on Friday nights from September 9th to October 7th starting at 6:30pm. In this study, we will walk through the main parts of the Mass - from the opening of the "Sign of the Cross", to the concluding "Thanks be to God".
