



Bereavement Ministry







Thoughts from Father Joseph Perreault Fourth of July – 2022

As most know, in one of great ironies of the American journey, both **Thomas Jefferson** and **John Adams**, would die on the same day (July 4, 1826), the 50th Anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. Less known is that **James Monroe** would pass 5 years later (July 4, 1831). Monroe, Ambassador to France, Secretary of State and fifth President of the United States, has often been described as the "last of the Founders". He once observed the following – "Our country maybe be likened to a new house. We lack many things, but we possess the most precious of all... liberty."

Coming together in prayer on this special weekend, it could be argued, I suppose, that our nation is no longer that "new house." However, as with any house - new or old - it will only be as secure as its' foundation... a foundation formed by a "sense of personal responsibility", for liberty without responsibility will eventually lead to chaos and a loss of perspective.
