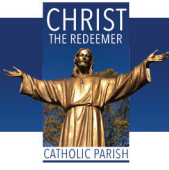

Bereavement Ministry

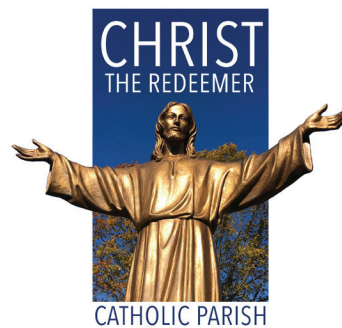

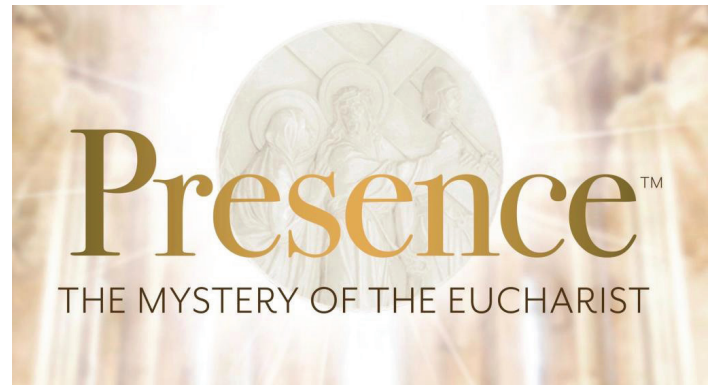

Message from Mary Peyerl, Adoration Coordinator:

Dear Parishioner,

When we receive the Eucharist, we receive Jesus in a supernatural way. Through a miracle he has transformed bread and wine into Himself. He loved us so much He gave His own self to us as a gift. When we receive Jesus in the Eucharist, His flesh bonds with ours. His blood mingles with our blood, and our hearts begin to beat more like His. We have been permanently changed for the better. Each time we receive Jesus in a state of grace, we are more and more like Him. We see with his eyes; we listen with His ears and we love with His heart.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is when Jesus in the Eucharist is able to be adored while He is placed on the altar. We all have things that go on in our lives that we ourselves have no control over. I go to Jesus. I always get an answer. Not always what I expected but what Jesus thought was best. I realize later that He knows what is best. Jesus can see things we cannot see. If not for my time with Jesus, I would not see the big picture in my life. I can even see how things that are not so nice can somehow turn out to be a real learning experience. I can only say my life has never been the same since Jesus has become my best friend and counselor.
