



# Message from Homebound Ministry Coordinator

Dear Parishioner,

My name is Marie Smith, aka "The Church Lady". I was born and raised in South Philadelphia to an Italian Catholic family. You know us – no meat on Friday. I still practice this tradition. We attended Mass every Sunday and never talked on Good Friday between the hours of 12:00 Noon to 3:00pm. I remember the May processions through the streets of So. Philly.

I met my husband Charles Smith, aka Deacon Smith, while working near one another and we were married in St. Monica's Church. He was a police officer and it was while he was getting ready to retire that we decided to move to New Jersey. We started to look for a place to live and Chuck always said that God was leading us to Atco and the Assumption Parish.

We became Eucharistic ministers together bringing Jesus to the sick and homebound of the parish. We later started visiting the Fountains on a weekly basis and in time we had over 25 residents each week attending services.

I lost my father, mother and brother all within a few years and then when Chuck passed away, I was lost and thought, how will I go on? But God always has a plan for us. My daughter Cindy and son-in-law Bob came to my rescue. I moved in with them, lock, stock and barrel.

I have met a lot of people on my journey who have helped me. Because of the Covid virus, I missed visiting the sick and homebound but I'm on my way back! So come and join me at Mass every week. Let's listen together to the Word of God and receive Him in the Eucharist, and give thanks and praise for all His gifts.
