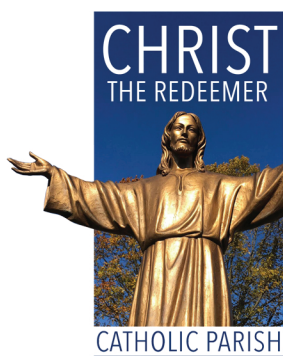

Bereavement Ministry

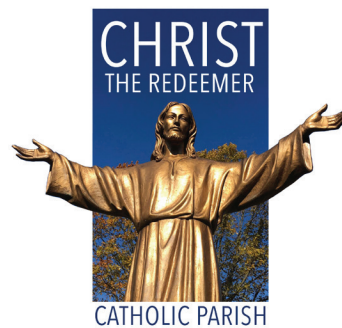

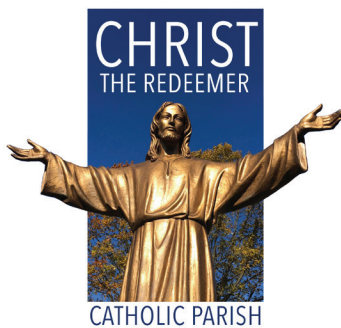

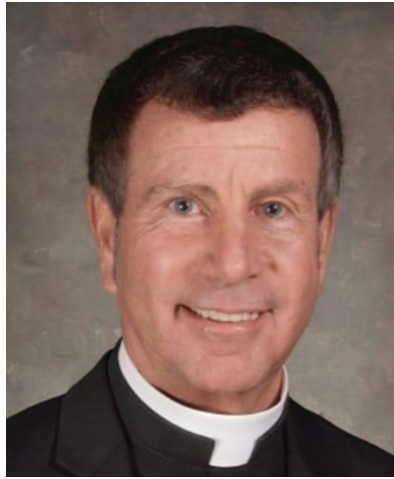
Prayer to ST RITA in special need
