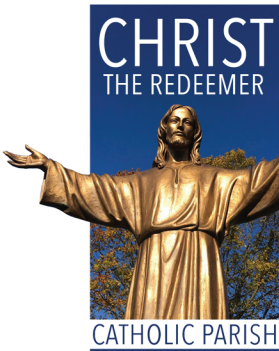

Bereavement Ministry

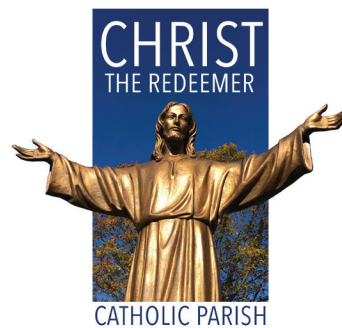

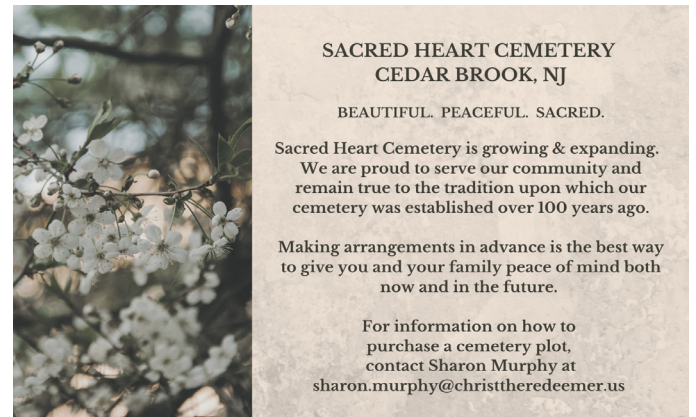
Quilting Ministry

Eden Stewardship

**May 22nd, 2022 - 6th Sunday of Easter
Fearless Stewardship**

*"...Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid."
(JOHN 14:27)*

Our limited human understanding cannot begin to understand the immense power of God. Instead of trusting in God, we often think we can control every outcome. Do you want to make God laugh? Tell Him your plans. The next time worry, anxiety or fear creeps in, thank God for all He has given you and trust that He has a **Stewardship** plan for you. Make God your first choice and not your last resort.

In 2021, Pew Research did a study and told us that 3 in 10 people in the U.S. are “NONES”. “None’s” is the term for Unaffiliated, which means people who identify themselves as atheists, agnostics, or “nothing in particular” when it comes to religion. In 2021, self-identified Christians in the U.S. made up 63% of the population but 10 years earlier it was 75%! Why the decline?
