

Pentecost Sunday

Gloria

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father. Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us. For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father.

1st Reading - Acts of the Apostles 2: 1-11

When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim. Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven staying in Jerusalem. At this sound, they gathered in a large crowd, but they were confused because each one heard them speaking in his own language. They were astounded, and in amazement they asked, "Are not all these people who are speaking Galileans? Then how does each of us hear them in his native language? We are Parthians, Medes, and Elamites, inhabitants of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the districts of Libya near Cyrene, as well as travelers from Rome, both Jews and converts to Judaism, Cretans and Arabs, yet we hear them speaking in our own tongues of the mighty acts of God."

Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth.

2nd Reading - 1 Corinthians 12: 3b-7, 12-13

Brothers and sisters:

No one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit. There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit.

As a body is one though it has many parts, and all the parts of the body, though many, are one body, so also Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, slaves or free persons, and we were all given to drink of one Spirit.

Gospel - John 20: 19-23

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained."


(At the words that follow, up to and including "and became man" all bow.)





Did You Ever Wonder...? Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA)

Our Faith is not simply a set of rules to help us through life. It unlocks the meaning to life itself, and has a depth to it that many Catholics might not understand. When we use words like God, Jesus, the Bible, or freedom, many people don't grasp them in their full meaning. Or worse, some misunderstand them, and wind up with a confused understanding of our Faith.

But when these deeper meanings are discovered we find that the truth, value, and wisdom of the Catholic Faith shows forth in a way that it never could before.

We will be getting together each week to look at some of these foundational concepts. If you are Catholic, thinking about the Catholic Faith, or just wondering if it makes any sense, you are invited to join us. We expect the sessions to last about 90 minutes.

Coffee and light snacks will be provided along with a free and open discussion. Any sincere questions or ideas will be respectfully entertained.

We really hope you'll be surprised, challenged, and perhaps even delighted by what you hear.

All sessions will be on Wednesday nights and will start at 7PM, in the 7th Grade Classroom in the Pastoral Center.

Below are the topics that will be covered.

June 7: Introduction and discussion: "Does Life mean anything? Everything? Nothing?"

June 14: Faith and Reason... what do they mean, and do they conflict?

June 28: What and Who is God? What about Jesus?

July 5: What and Who is man? What does God want of us?

July 12: How do we know what to believe?

July 19: What is the Church? Why is the Church?

June 21: Reality, Love, and Freedom

July 26: Prayer: What is prayer, really, and why

First Friday Holy Hour with Vespers

Beginning with the **First Friday of June**, we will be starting a Holy Hour of Eucharistic Adoration in Assumption Church **starting at 6 pm**. As part of this we will be praying Vespers for Friday with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Vespers is the traditional evening prayer of the Church and is part of the Liturgy of the Hours. It consists of psalms, scripture readings and intercessions. Printed pamphlets will be available. Deacon Joe will lead us - no prior experience or other resources are necessary.

Please consider including this monthly activity in your prayer life as we enter the Parish Phase of the Eucharistic Revival. Praying the Liturgy of the Hours in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament can be a particularly meaningful and fruitful way to enhance your relationship with Our Lord.




