



Bereavement Ministry







Dedication of St. Rita of Cascia Parish Hall







Thank you, Father Wallace, for dedicating the St. Rita of Cascia Parish Hall on May 21st!

Many years ago, Mr. John Pangia, grandfather of Mr. Albert Pangia of our Parish, after receiving favors from Saint Rita, began a tradition of strong devotion to her. The devotions included donating roses on her feast day, processions by school children, and noven in her honor.

Since 2015, the devotion to St. Rita of Cascia was revived at Christ the Redeemer. Al Pangia established the St. Rita of Cascia rose garden, with a statue of her in front of the hall. In 2018, Albert donated another statue of St. Rita which is located in the Church. This year he donated a portrait of St. Rita that is more than 100 years old that belonged to his grandfather.

To all the devotees and those "behind the scenes", thank you for supporting the St. Rita of Cascia Ministry in our Parish.



In late 2019, a Pew Study indicated what many had long suspected. Few Catholics, only about 30 percent, fully believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

This stark reality inspired the Bishops of the United States to action. More than an event or a program, they envisioned a true Revival to rediscover the source and summit of our Faith through a deep commitment to prayer, pilgrimage, and worship on the part of the entire Church in the United States.

Taking its title from the Bread of Life discourse in John's Gospel, "My flesh for the life of the world/Mi carne para la vida del mundo," the Eucharistic Revival is not a step-by-step plan or a series of meetings; it is a grassroots call and a challenge for every Catholic across the United States to rekindle the fire of love and devotion for the Eucharistic Heart of Jesus.

Over three years, every Catholic diocese, parish, school, apostolate, and family is invited to be a part of **renewing the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist**. This Revival launches on the Feast of Corpus Christi, June 18/19, 2022.

In our diocese, on the vigil of the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, **Saturday**, **June 18, 2022**, Bishop Sullivan will lead a **Candlelight Corpus Christi Procession** on the Boardwalk in Atlantic City. It will start at 8:00pm at Tennessee Ave and the Boardwalk, process three-quarters of a mile with three stations for adoration and prayer, and conclude at Kennedy Plaza at approximately 9:15pm. In the event of rain, we will gather at Saint Nicholas of Tolentine Church. **All parishioners are invited to process behind our Christ the Redeemer Parish banner**.

In our parish during the month of June, we will be offering a 3 part video series entitled, **Presence: The Mystery of the Eucharist**, which explores the truth and beauty of Christ's Real Presence in the Eucharist, from its origins in Sacred Scripture, to its profound role in the life of the Church and its members. **Please join us on Tuesdays, June 14, 21 and 28 at 6:30pm in Assumption Church.**
