GUIDELINES & RULES FOR MONUMENT DEALERS

All requests for memorialization must be submitted to the parish office using our Application to Erect Memorial form.

The form must be signed by the person who has the authority to request the memorialization, and completed with specifications, dimensions, and sketch. Incomplete forms will be returned. Full payment for installation and foundation fees needs to be submitted with this application, as appropriate, to the parish office.

No work should be initiated until you receive an approved application. Once the granite marker, monument, or lettering has been installed, the original application must be returned to the cemetery office along with any warranty guarantee documents. Delivery of markers or monuments must be scheduled in advance with the parish office by calling Monday-Thursday during normal business hours. No work is to be performed outside of normal parish hours. Available delivery times are typically Monday to Thursday from 10 AM to 3:30 PM, depending on scheduled funerals. All deliveries must be reviewed and approved by a field employee before installation to ensure quality and accuracy. Under no circumstances is the unapproved memorialization to be done on our premises.

Any monument erected in our Catholic cemetery is intended not only as a memorial to those laid to rest there, but also to reinforce the sacred nature of the place where the human remains of God's people are resting in anticipation of their resurrection. Because of the holiness and the Catholic identity of the cemetery, we require that a Catholic symbol be the predominant artistic symbol on the stone. Appropriate Catholic symbols include, but are not limited to, a cross, crucifix, dove for the Holy Spirit, and praying hands holding the rosary. Names, birth dates, and death dates of the deceased should also be prominently inscribed. Additional ornamentation, such as floral or geometric designs, other sacred symbols, and emblems of fraternal organizations, is permitted, provided their presence on the monument is understated in relation to the primary Catholic symbol. Memorialization of pets is not permitted in any form.

If a franchised symbol or logo (e.g., favorite sports team) is requested on a stone, the image must be included on the drawings submitted for approval, and the image cannot be the predominant feature on the stone. Typically, only one side of a monument or slant stone can be engraved. If engraving on the back of the monument is being requested, you must include a separate sheet of paper with a sketch of the planned engraving and any related images. No personal images of the deceased or memorialization are permitted on the back of the stone.

A 3 1/2" veteran or military service engraved insignia is permitted in all cases, with the exception of flush or flat markers, where the 1 1/2" size is permitted. The engraved insignia size and description must be shown on the monument application, in the sketch part of the form.

Foundation fee for monuments costs \$1.00 per square inch per footprint of monument, 16" deep of wet pour concrete.

Should any memorial, in the opinion of the director or superintendent, become unsightly, dilapidated or dangerous to visitors, it is understood that the cemetery shall have the right either to correct the condition or to remove the same at the expense of the lot owner or his or her heirs, after giving due notice in writing to the last known address of the lot owner on file in the cemetery office. The cemetery is NOT responsible for acts of vandalism.
