

## Gospel Matthew 25: 1-13

Jesus told his disciples this parable:

"The kingdom of heaven will be like ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. Five of them were foolish and five were wise. The foolish ones, when taking their lamps, brought no oil with them, but the wise brought flasks of oil with their lamps. Since the bridegroom was long delayed, they all became drowsy and fell asleep. At midnight, there was a cry, 'Behold, the bridegroom! Come out to meet him!' Then all those virgins got up and trimmed their lamps. The foolish ones said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' But the wise ones replied, 'No, for there may not be enough for us and you. Go instead to the merchants and buy some for yourselves.' While they went off to buy it, the bridegroom came and those who were ready went into the wedding feast with him. Then the door was locked. Afterwards the other virgins came and said, 'Lord, Lord, open the door for us!' But he said in reply, 'Amen, I say to you, I do not know you.' Therefore, stay awake, for you know neither the day nor the hour."



## *A Message from Father Wallace*

Dear Parishioners,

There is a person here at the parish who has become very dear to all of us and who serves the Lord in our parish by providing us with religious education and formation. Laurie Power is our Director of Religious Education and she will soon go through a solemn ceremony at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception where she is going to publicly vow her life to service of God's people as a consecrated virgin. This will take place on Tuesday, November 21, 2023, at 5pm at the Cathedral, 642 Market St., Camden, N.J. We are all welcome and encouraged to attend this beautiful and ancient ceremony. We will celebrate with Laurie here at our own parish at the **4pm liturgy on Saturday, November 25, 2023, followed by a reception in St. Rita Hall around 5pm**. Again, all are welcome and encouraged to join in our parish celebration of Laurie's consecration to total service to Jesus Christ!

The tradition of total dedication as a consecrated virgin predates Christianity in the Jewish tradition. Women and girls were dedicated to service in the Temple of Jerusalem, as temple virgins and widows. This practice was also exercised in the ancient Church with a new tradition of women consecrating their lives and virginity to the Lord Jesus Christ and entering a lifelong commitment of prayer and service to the Church. These ancient practices of women and men eventually lead to the practice and tradition of monastic and religious orders in the Church.

One of the decisions of the Second Vatican Council was to restore this ancient practice in the Church. And so, in line with the Vatican II document, *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, the Rite of Consecration was restored and revised to once again in the contemporary Church bring this ancient practice back to life. Thus, Laurie standing before the bishop, who stands in for the Eternal Bridegroom Jesus Christ, will express ritually her willingness to freely consecrate her life as a Bride of Christ. Like other consecrated virgins in the world, Laurie will vow to preserve for the entirety of her life perfect chastity and promise to serve God and the Church, following Christ and His Gospel. She is called to live as an end time witness of the love of God in this world.

Though she will live in the world, not in a religious house or religious order, she will, however, dedicate her life like all the consecrated virgins before her by attending daily Mass, praying the Liturgy of the Hours, and spending time in personal prayer and spiritual reading. She now will be a sign of the Kingdom in the world through her total dedication and consecration.

With you I thank God for the gift of Laurie Power in our parish and in our lives. Please join us in celebrating this important step in Laurie's life both at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Camden and here at Christ the Redeemer Parish!


