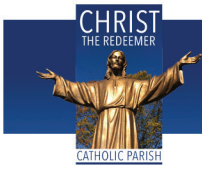

Bereavement Ministry

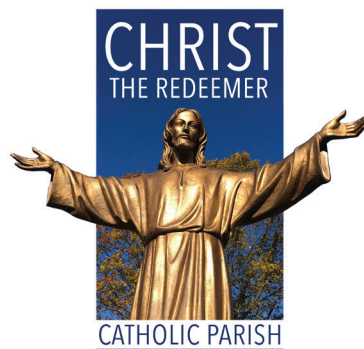
