Reintroduction of the Blood of Christ During Holy Communion

Beginning with the first Sunday of Advent, November 30th and December 1st, Christ the Redeemer will reintroduce the Blood of Christ along with the Body of Christ during communion at all masses.

You are not required to consume both the Body and Blood since Christ is truly present in either species, but a fuller light shines on the Eucharistic banquet when you do receive both.

When drinking from the cup, first bow, then say "Amen" to the minister, in a sincere tone that reveals your faith in the Blood of Christ before you. Then receive the cup in both hands, and take a drink. A good sip. Somewhere between wetting the lips and swallowing hard. Enjoy the full symbol of the Eucharistic banquet with reverence and delight.




