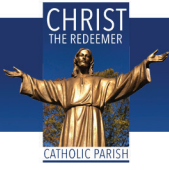

CPR CLASSES

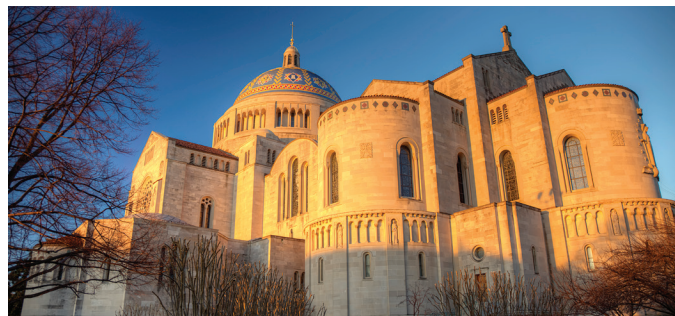

Also, it is not permitted to plant bushes or trees at a grave site in the cemetery. Bushes and trees encroach on neighboring plots and can impact the vault. If you have planted a bush or tree, we encourage you to remove it before the next cleanup date which is scheduled for **October 31st**. Our maintenance team will remove all non-conforming items during the cleanup.

Bereavement Ministry

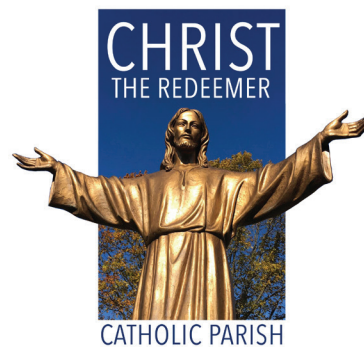
