


# Additional Information About Sacred Heart Cemetery

The Parish aims to maintain Sacred Heart Cemetery to the highest standards possible. It is with this in mind that we have adopted rules and regulations for memorials and decorations. As a reminder, Sacred Heart Cemetery is not responsible for damage to plants, decorations, or any other items that are placed on the graves. Also, it is not permitted to plant bushes or trees at a grave site in the cemetery. Bushes and trees encroach on neighboring plots and can impact the vault. If you have planted a bush or tree, we encourage you to remove it before the next cleanup date which is scheduled for October 31st. Our maintenance team will remove all non-conforming items during the cleanup.

# **Bereavement Ministry**


