





**Almsgiving:** The works of mercy are charitable actions by which we come to the aid of our neighbor in his spiritual and bodily necessities. Among all these, giving alms to the poor is one of the chief witnesses to fraternal charity: it is also a work of justice pleasing to God. (CCC 2447)

### Additional Information About Sacred Heart Cemetery



As a reminder, Sacred Heart Cemetery is not responsible for damage to plants, decorations, or any other items that are placed on the graves. Also, it is not permitted to plant bushes or trees at a grave site in the cemetery. Bushes and trees encroach on neighboring plots and can impact the vault. If you have planted a bush or tree, we encourage you to remove it before the next cleanup date which is scheduled for **October 31st**. Our maintenance team will remove all non-conforming items during the cleanup.


