1. Pray the Psalms or the Liturgy of the Hours. Whether you are praising, giving thanks, asking for forgiveness or seeking an answer, you'll find an appropriate psalm. The ancient prayer of the Church, called the Liturgy of the Hours, presents an excellent way to pray through the book of Psalms throughout the year.
2. Recite the "Jesus Prayer." Say "Lord Jesus Christ, have mercy on me a sinner," repeatedly as you quiet your heart and mind.

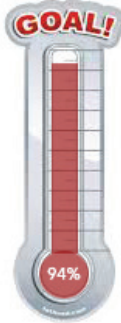

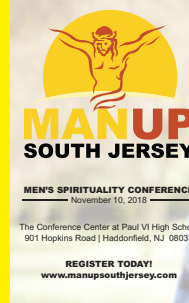

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd: Creating a Sacred Space for Children - Coming This Fall!

“Pure JOY!”

For Preschool and Kindergarten Children

“We believe that God and the child have a unique relationship with one another particularly before the age of six and that the growth of this relationship should be assisted by the adult, but is directed by the Spirit of God within the child. Children need their own place to foster the growth of that relationship.”

“CGSUSA was formed in 1984 in North America with its main aim being that of ‘involving adults and children in a common religious experience in which the religious values of childhood (contemplation and enjoyment of God) are predominant.’ ”

Characteristics of CGS:

*“With this aim in mind, the catechist embraces Maria Montessori’s vision of the human being and thus the attitude of the adult regarding the child; and prepares an environment called **the atrium**, which aids the development of the religious life.”*

“The atrium is a place in which the only Teacher is Christ; both children and adults place themselves in a listening stance before his Word and seek to penetrate the mystery of the liturgical celebration.”

“The themes presented in the atrium are those to which the children have responded with depth and joy. These themes are taken from the Bible and the liturgy (prayers and sacraments) as the fundamental sources for creating and sustaining Christian life at every developmental stage and, in particular, for illuminating and nourishing the child in his/her most vital religious needs.”

Catechists work with the children to “try to reach the integration of hand, mind and heart.”
